Sunday

That they will come to know Christ early in life

And how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. 2 Timothy 3:15

That they will grow in their relationship with Christ

But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and forever! Amen. 2 Peter 3:18

That they will be single-hearted, willing to be sold out to Jesus Christ

Tuesday

That their wrong actions will be corrected

It was good for me to be afflicted so that I might learn your decrees. Psalm 119:71

That they will have a hatred for sin

That they will confess their sin

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9

Wednesday

That they will be kept from the wrong mate and kept for the right one

Thursday

That they will be protected in each one of their lives: spiritual, emotional, physical

That they will totally submit to God and resist Satan in all circumstances

Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:7

Friday

That they will obey their parents

Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord. Colossians 3:20

That they will learn to submit to those in authority

Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God. Romans 13:1

That they will love God and other people

Saturday

That they will desire the right kind of friends and be protected from the wrong kind
